



City of Moore Parks and Recreation Park Rules

- 1) The Parks and Recreation Director is authorized to establish rules and regulations that govern the use of specific parks, trails, natural areas, and recreation facilities in any manner that provides for the productive, sustainable and safe operation and use for safety of citizens and facilities as he or she deems necessary
- 2) No person shall engage in a criminal activity while in district facilities or on district property. All criminal activity shall be reported to the Moore Police Department
- 3) Athletic practices or athletic activities are prohibited at city facilities or underneath structures i.e. (multi-purpose pavilion, amphitheater, pavilions, etc....) for purpose of citizen safety and damage to facilities
- 4) No athletic balls are allowed to be kicked, hit or thrown against fences
- 3) Golfing is prohibited in park land for purpose of citizen safety
- 5) No skateboarding, rollerblading or riding bikes at amphitheater or pavilion grounds
- 6) No motorized vehicles at Central Park amphitheater or pavilion grounds
- 7) No diving or swimming in ponds
- 8) No fishing in ponds
- 9) No sleeping or "camping" in city facilities or park land
- 10) No unauthorized vending, sales or advertising on public property permitted.
- 11) No person shall disturb, injure or endanger the comfort, health, peace or safety of others on district property.
- 12) No unauthorized person shall cut, remove or damage vegetation on district property.
- 13) No person shall sell merchandise or services, or operate a concession on district property without permission of the district and shall possess, on their person, evidence of such approval
- 14) The use of any device that amplifies sound on district property shall be regulated in accordance with City code
- 15) No glass bottles or any glass containers allowed in parks
- 16) The sale of goods and services requires a Parks and Recreation and/or City of Moore permit
