I hope your summer is going well! I wanted to take a moment to update you on the progress of the GO Bond projects that are currently underway in our city.

Firstly, I am pleased to inform you that Eastern Avenue between SE 4th and SE 19th has been completed. This is an important milestone that will improve the connectivity and accessibility in our community.

Additionally, the engineering and design portion is nearing completion for the NW 27th and Shields Blvd project and the Telephone Rd (between SW 19th and SW 34th) project. The utility relocation for these projects will start in January of 2025, bringing us one step closer to improving the infrastructure in those areas.

Lastly, we are expecting the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) to award the construction contract for the SE 4th street railroad underpass this September. Construction typically starts 90 days following contract letting. This project will significantly enhance the traffic flow and safety in that area.

Thank you for your continued support and patience as we work towards making Moore an even better place to live, work, and raise a family.
