### ENTRY PASS POLICY

If a patron exits the facilities, a new entry pass will need to be purchased for re-entry.

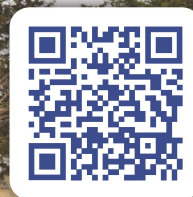
